WHO IS THE AMA?

- American Medical Association
- National Professional Association of physicians and medical students
- Established the AMA PRA Credit System
 - To demonstrate that physicians have participated in approved CME activities
 - Sets rules and regulations for CME activities and the awarding of credits

AMA



The phrase "AMA PRA Category 1 Credit(s)™" must be italicized whenever it is used.

Examples:

- ♦ This activity will offer 3 AMA PRA Category 1 Credits™.
- ♦ The Maine Medical Education Trust designates this live activity for a maximum of 3 AMA PRA Category 1 Credits™. Physicians should only claim credit commensurate with the extent of their participation in the activity.

When referring to 'AMA Credit', the whole phrase 'AMA PRA Category 1 Credit™' must be used.

The Maine Medical Exation Trust is accredited by the Maine Medical Association's Committee on Continuing Medical Education and Accreditation to provide continuing medical education for physicians.

The AMA does NOT require certificates to be issued to learners.

However,

It does require that the accredited CME provider be able to provide documentation to physicians at their request.


This could be a transcript or a certificate.

The AMA does not set a limit on the amount of time physicians have to claim credits.

However,

Accredited Providers have the authority to set a limit.

Physicians should be made aware of what the time limit is to claim credits.



The AMA Credit Designation Statement does NOT have to be included on certificates issued to learners.

The documentation provided should reflect the number of credits claimed/awarded, rather than automatically including the designated maximum for the activity.

The Maine Medical Education Trust designates this live activity for a maximum of *3 AMA PRA Category 1 Credits*™. Physicians should only claim credit commensurate with the extent of their participation in the activity.

Certificates and Transcripts must contain the specific number of credits claimed by a physician.



Do not have to provide direct access to the source materials.

AMA PRA Category 1 Credit[™] can be awarded to faculty for preparing and teaching a live presentation.

- The presentation must be original and can only be claimed once.
- Cannot be claimed for creation of enduring materials.
- ♦ Credit is awarded on a 2:1 ratio to presentation time (e.g., 2 AMA PRA Category 1 Credit(s)™ for a 1-hour presentation)

AMA PRA Category 1 Credit[™] can be awarded to faculty for preparing and teaching a live presentation.

- Physicians can apply directly to the AMA for credit (fee)
- Accredited CME providers may develop Faculty Credit as a CME activity.

AMA PRA Category 1 Credit™ can be claimed for attending international conferences.

CME can be claimed for activities that are:

Certified by a U.S.-based accredited CME provider Certified for Royal
College of Physicians
and Surgeons of Canada
MOC Credit

Certified for Qatar Council for Healthcare Practitioners CPD credit

Recognized through the AMA's International Conference Recognition Program

Approved by the European

Continuing Medical
Education

Physicians may be able to self-claim *AMA PRA Category 2 Credit*™

- 2. When referring to 'AMA Credit', the whole phrase 'AMA PRA Category 1 Credit(s)™' must be used.

 - 4. The AMA does not require certificates to be issued to learners.
 - 5. The AMA does not set a limit on the amount of time physicians have to claim credits.
