During the 1996 legislative session, the presiding officers of the Maine Legislature asked the Maine Medical Association and the Maine Osteopathic Association to furnish a physician for each legislative day to assist in the event of a medical emergency. Since then, the Doctor of the Day program has become a well-established and highly respected service. This is a unique opportunity to observe the legislative process in action and to visit lawmakers. The program also gives your child(ren) a chance to observe their government in action by serving as an honorary page.

Upon receipt of your registration, MMA staff will contact you to arrange a convenient date for you to serve. The House Clerk's office will then send you a confirmation letter and parking pass. On the day of your participation, a Maine Medical Association representative will meet you at the State House and will be available to orient you to the State House and guide you through the legislative activities of the day.
