Additional considerations:

- a) Practices that participate in MMA’s FQHC Membership Program will have a 15% discount applied to the first two reviews. For more information about this program, contact dpoulin@mainemed.com.
- b) The fee for on-site reviews does not include travel time, overnight expenses, mileage, food, etc.
- c) Expenses, other than the direct fee, will be submitted by the reviewer to the MMA.
- d) Associated expenses (i.e. postage / shipping fees) could be an additional expense to the requestor.
- e) For every 3 reviews ordered in a 12-month period, the fourth review will be offered at a 15% discounted rate (not to exceed \$500)
- f) Changes in the fee schedule may be changed from time to time. Any new fees will be communicated to the requestor before the process is initiated.
- g) The fee will differ based on the number of reviewers.
- h) The Director for MMA’s External Peer Review Program at her discretion may adjust some fees if the reviewer spends less or more time on their analysis.**
