Additional considerations:

- a) The fee for on-site reviews includes travel time, overnight expenses, mileage, food, etc.
- b) Expenses, other than the direct fee, will be submitted by the reviewer to the MMA.
- c) Associated expenses (i.e. postage / shipping fees) could be an additional expense to the requestor.
- d) If a requesting organization does a number of reviews (excluding recredentialing) in a 12-month period, a reduction in the above fee schedule may be considered.
- e) Changes in the fee schedule may be changed from time to time. Any new fees will be communicated to the requestor before the process is initiated.
- f) The fee will differ based on the number of reviewers.
