² You must make available prices for the health care services and procedures that you provided at least 50 times in the preceding (2013) calendar year - this could be 10 services or over 1,000, depending on your size and type of practice; the prices stated must be accompanied by descriptions of the services and procedures and the applicable standard medical codes or CPT codes - the list and prices provided here are for demonstration purposes only.

³ The prices stated must be the full price that you would charge patients directly when there is no insurance coverage for the service – before taking into account any discount or charity care policy; you may inform patients of any discounts.
